

## **Minutes Calne Without Parish Council Meeting 4th June 2007**

2. The Chairman welcomed Christine Paxford and thanked her for standing in for the Clerk. The Clerk is now out of hospital and sent his thanks for his cards. He will deal with correspondence and emails but would prefer phone calls be kept to a minimum.

3. Public Speaking Time

There were no members of the public present.

4. Minutes of the last meeting

These were agreed as a true record and duly signed.

Councillor Hare asked that it be minuted that he was very unhappy about the way the last meeting was conducted because the decision made regarding the Scout hut at the meeting in April had been overturned, and the item had not been on the agenda for discussion. The Chairman explained that the Council had not been aware that this would be discussed until it was brought up during Public Speaking time, and after this the Councillors present at the meeting decided they would like to review their previous decision.

5. Co-opt West Ward Councillor

Colin Bell advised he was prepared to stand as a Councillor and was proposed by Lord Lansdowne. Seconded Councillor Eadon. Majority in favour. Councillor Bell was elected and joined the meeting.

6. Planning

Councillor Baker declared an interest in 07/01274/FUL. Plans still not received. Lord Lansdowne declared an interest in 07/00248, 07/00249 and 07/00575.

Councillor Hare queried 07/00896/LBC and after some discussion Councillor Hare proposed the Council write and make the observation that it was inappropriate for a listed building to be painted when it is not needed, and that PVC materials need not be used because the originals could be replaced. Seconded Councillor Warner. Majority in favour.

There was some discussion regarding 07/01283/CLE but the Council has not received anything regarding this. Residents concerned were asked to speak. Lord Lansdowne proposed that East Ward Councillors be given full authority to make a decision regarding this. Majority in favour.

Councillors had a copy of the accounts and these were proposed by Lord Lansdowne. Majority in favour.
