2 **Public Speaking Time**

5 **Planning**

Wellington Barn 09/00392/COU

Councillor Eadon advised he had personally written supporting the application and offered to read letter to Council. Large number of Calstone public discussed the application for increased usage of the Barn. Majority concerns on noise expected from increased usage. After much discussion it was **Proposed Lord Lansdowne, Seconded Councillor Miller, Agreed Unanimously** that the application should be accepted, with recommendation of a 12 month review by the local community, to ensure management and proposed noise reduction methods had been effective. Councillor Eadon advised that 09/00406/FUL now met with local residents' approval.
