## **Minutes of Parish Council Meeting 4<sup>th</sup> July 2011**

### 2 **Public Speaking**

Mrs Wallis spoke over concerns with the Studley A4 Crossing. She detailed who she had contacted and advised she was forming an action group to raise support and funds, to implement possible solutions. Mrs Wallis asked questions on group funding and financial records.

Andrea Pellegram spoke on behalf of Hills Lower Compton Waste Management Facility, explaining that planning applications were to be submitted for waste collection and processing services in October and to explain details and hear Councillor concerns. Similar discussions had taken place with other parish councils and the Area Board

Discussion took place on

- increased traffic movements in Calne and alternative routes
- crossing and speed limits at Lower Compton
- local employment implications
- increased traffic movements which were expected to be 10%
- improvements at Lower Compton that could be combined with proposed changes

**Core Strategy**

Councillor Crisp was asked for her views on strategy in relation to Calne Without. Council decided not to respond to the core strategy document.

9 **Any Questions**

Councillor Vines asked for progress with the cycle path seat. Clerk advised Clerk  
Wiltshire Council were actively trying to fund. It was agreed unanimously  
to allow Wiltshire Council further time to progress solution.

Councillor Bamfield raised the problem of overgrown vegetation along path between Hall and A4, Councillor Johnstone advised similar problem on path from Hall to School. Agreed unanimously to raise with Steward.

Councillor Johnstone raised concern with two parked vehicles on the Clerk  
highway at Stockley. It was agreed unanimously to ascertain if it was  
possible to get them moved.

Councillor Jones spoke further on Studley cross roads, advising that the Council supported the work of Mrs Wallis and asked for the Parish Council to be kept updated.

Councillor Aylen asked if Wiltshire Council policy on weeds growing Clerk  
through pathways could be ascertained, as there were some problem  
areas in Derry Hill.
