Dog Waste Bin: Studley

Introduction

West Ward Councillors have been working on a location for a dog waste bin following a request from a local resident.

Site

The site being suggested for the bin is in the vicinity of Studley Gardens and the access onto the adjacent public footpath.

The introduction of a permissive path by the Bowood Estate will provide a link between the new housing development and the existing footpath with runs to the west of the development. This provides a logical site for a bin. The actual siting of the bin either on the housing development or the path need to be confirmed and then checked with the landowner before the bin can be put in place.

Cost of the bin

2. That the Council chose a supplier for the bin and approve the purchase of the bin from the Community Facilities budget heading using Community Infrastructure Levy Funds. Purchase to be made by the Clerk, any final quotes resulting from any changes or locational requirement to be approved by the Clerk and a nominated Councillor.
