5 Funding Request: Derry Hill and Studley Heartbeat

Recommendations:

- I. Regular committed funding of £350 per year funded from Precept for a specified number of years.
- II. Funding of £1420 as one-off grant payment to be funded from Community Infrastructure Levy Reserve or Sun Edison Fund
- III. Funding of £350 per year up to 2023/24 to be funded from ring fenced Community Infrastructure Levy Reserves.
- 2. That the Committee budget for ongoing maintenance liabilities for the phone box on Church Road in the 2021/22 budget and ask the Council to enter into a Hosting Agreement with DH&SH.

6 Credit Card, Savings Account and Bank Mandates

Recommendation: That the Finance Committee recommend to the Council an addition to the Council's Standing Orders and Financial Regulations regarding the Councils ability to borrow.

7 Neighbourhood Plan Review: Funding

To consider the possibility of providing funding in 20/21 and 21/22 for the work of the Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group including employment of Consultants, survey work, public consultation and administration costs. Calne Town Council has allocated £5000. Grants are available and submission of applications are to be considered prior to any major costs being incurred.

8 Budget for 2021/22

To review the current budget and spending and establish the commitments and principles to be considered in the drafting of the budget for 2021/22.

Recommendation:

That the Committee detail the principles on which it wishes to draft the budget for 2021/22 for agreement by the Parish Council on 9th November 2020. This will include:

- Any new budget headings and commitments
- Increases above £100 on existing budget headings,
- Project Categories and the projects that it would like to see progressed in 21/22
